Note from Fr. Bill: I have found much inspiration in the writings of Fr. Ron Rolheiser. In his weekly article, "In Exile" (see New Freeman), he quotes many contemporary writers in the area of spirituality. In May 2015 he gave a list of spiritual writers that he believes are highly influential today in the English -speaking world and their names and quotes frequently find there place in his writings. Over the next few weeks I will share this list with you.

One of these people is Marilynne Robinson an American novelist. Ron Rolheiser says, "she is not a spirituality writer per se, but an exceptional novelist whose characters express her spirituality. She is an exceptional apologetic voice." These are some quotes from her novel **Gilead:**

"Christianity is a life, not a doctrine . . . I'm not saying never doubt or question. The Lord gave you a mind so that you would make honest use of it. I'm saying you must be sure that the doubts and questions are your own."

"I don't know exactly what covetous is, but in my experience it is not so much desiring someone else's virtue or happiness as rejecting it, taking offense at the beauty of it."

"The moon looks wonderful in this warm evening light, just as a candle flame looks beautiful in the light of morning. Light within light...It seems to me to be a metaphor for the human soul, the singular light within that great general light of existence."

"Grace has a grand laughter in it."

"There are a thousand reasons to live this life, everyone of them sufficient"

"In every important way we are such secrets from one another, and I do believe that there is a separate language in each of us, also a separate aesthetics and a separate jurisprudence. Every single one of us is a little civilization built on the ruins of any number of preceding civilizations, but with our own variant notions of what is beautiful and what is acceptable - which, I hasten to add, we generally do not satisfy and by which we struggle to live. We take fortuitous resemblances among us to be actual likeness, because those around us have also fallen heir to the same customs, trade in the same coin, acknowledge, more or less, the same notions of decency and sanity. But all that really just allows us to coexist with the inviolable, intraversable, and utterly vast spaces between us."

"It all means more than I can tell you. So you must not judge what I know by what I find words for."

"These people who can see right through you never quite do you justice, because they never give you credit for the effort you're making to be better than you actually are, which is difficult and well meant and deserving of some little notice."

"Love is holy because it is like grace--the worthiness of its object is never really what matters

The following are five spiritual writers recommended by Fr. Ron Rolheiser:

- Annie Dillard: American, Roman Catholic (convert) lay. Her writings invariably articulate an aesthetic and moral insight that is a natural friend of religion.
- Elizabeth Johnson: American, Roman Catholic, nun. An exceptional mentor for those who are searching for a better intellectual apologia for their faith.
- Henri Nouwen: Dutch/American, Roman Catholic, priest. Perhaps the most widely-read and mostinfluential among all contemporary authors in spirituality.
- Parker Palmer: Quaker, layman, American, muchrespected across all denominational lines. Has written brilliantly on the spirituality of education and on achieving a Christian balance in life.
- Michael Higgins: Canadian, layman, Roman Catholic. Does a lot of highly insightful journalistic commentary on contemporary spirituality. The official biographer of Nouwen. Former president of St. Thomas University.
