Note from Fr. Bill: This week my note features Fr. William J. Bausch. He is a well known story-teller, scripture commentator, parish priest and author of a number of books including, *Storytelling: Imagination and Faith*; *Storytelling the Word*; *Telling Stories*, *Compelling Stories*. All of his stories, which come from our universal library of tales and stories, aim to nudge, provoke and stimulate the reader and listener, to resonate with the human condition and move us into compassionate action, as did the stories of Jesus. Here are two of these stories from his book, *A World of Stories* :

No Other Plans

Upon Jesus' arrival in heaven, a vast host of angels greeted him. After the formalities, they asked him whom he had left behind on earth to finish the work he had begun. Jesus replied, "Just a small group of men and women who love me." "That's all?" asked the angels, astonished. "What if this tiny group should fail?" Jesus replied, I have no other plans." (William J.
