She is the award winning poet, writer and author of the "New York Times" best sellers *The Cloister Walk, Acedia & Me: A Marriage, Monks, and a Writers Life, Dakota: A Spiritual Geography, Amazing Grace: A Vocabulary of Faith, and The Virgin of Bennington.* Exploring the spiritual life, her work has been a great companion and inspiration for those seeking a contemplative life in the midst of the ordinary routine, gift and adventure of our everyday lives. Some quotes:

"Prayer is not asking for what you think you want, but asking to be changed in ways you can't imagine."

"If grace is so wonderful, why do we have such difficulty recognizing and accepting it? Maybe it's because grace is not gentle or made—to—order. It often comes disguised as loss, or failure or unwelcome change."

"True hospitality is marked by an open response to the dignity of each and every person. Henri Nouwen has described it as receiving the stranger on their own terms, and asserts that it can be offered only by those who have found the center of their lives in their own hearts'. # From her book, <u>Acedia & Me: A Marriage, Monks</u>, and a Writers Life:

"For grace to be grace it must give us things we didn't know we needed and take us places we didn't know we didn't want to go. As we stumble through the crazily altered landscape of our lives, we find that God is enjoying our attention as never before."

"But hope has an astonishing resilience and strength. Its very persistence in our hearts indicates that it is not a tonic for wishful thinkers but the ground on which realists stand."

"Because we are made in God's image, in fleeing from a relationship with a loving God, we are also running from being our most authentic selves." ".... religious traditions build up meaning only over time and in a communal context. They can't be purchased like a burger or a pair of shoes."

"I was taught that I had to 'master' subjects. But who can 'master' beauty, or peace, or joy?"
