

There are pamphlets describing what Lectio Divina (Divine Reading) is and the steps to follow when praying it as an individual or in a small group. Kitchen Renovation: The Kitchen Renovation is complete! At our 2016 Annual Parish Meeting we let you know that the kitchen would be renovated at a cost of \$55K plus tax. . In order to adhere to building codes and food safety policies this renovation required a complete upgrading to our kitchen structure including electrical, plumbing, counter tops, cabinets and flooring.
