1. **Sunday (Saturday) Mass times:** We decided that we will keep our present schedule and continue to put our focus on making each of them as vibrant and as full as possible.
2. **The Next step in Choosing our New Parish Name:** In this week's bulletin there is a 'form' called '**My Choice of Name for the New Parish**'. You need to submit your choice of name by **October 21st**. The instructions are on the form inserted in the bulletin and at the entrances of our Church Sites.
